The Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme. The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society. If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change The Independent Federation of Nursing in Scotland must notify twenty eight days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If an error is made by The Independent Federation of Nursing in Scotland or your Bank or Building Society you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid. You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. METHODS OF PAYMENT

The Independent Federation of Nursing in Scotland's subscription is an annual fee of **£216.00**. The preferred method of payment is (please tick choice): -

1. **Monthly by Direct Debit**

Direct Debit is the method whereby you give your bank authority to debit your subscription of **£18.00** on or around the 1st of each month from your bank account. If you wish to pay your subscription by this method you must complete the Direct Debit mandate overleaf instructing your Bank or Building Society to pay by Direct Debit. Please ensure that you have included all of your bank details in the appropriate places.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE COMPLETED THE DIRECT DEBIT MANDATE PRIOR TO RETURNING THE COMPLETED FORM TO THE INDEPENDENT FEDERATION OF NURSING IN SCOTLAND.
